## 1. How do I enroll my child in Austin ISD?

In case you just moved into your new Austin home and haven't had time to enroll your child into AISD, here is where to start:

To enroll your child, you must go to the school your child should attend and provide a birth certificate, current record of immunizations, and the child's last report card. For Kindergarten eligibility, the student must be five years old on or before September 1st of the current year. For additional information,
